BIBLIOGRAPHY: Times New Roman, 11pt, italics, text justified with single line spacing

**APPENDICES** (if necessary, may include items such as a large chunk of code that is necessary to be a part of the paper but is inappropriate to be included in the paper body)

### **ACKNOWLEDGMENT**

Collate acknowledgements in a separate section at the end of the article before the references and do not, therefore, include them on the title page, as a footnote to the title or otherwise.

### **CITING REFERENCES**

Please ensure that every reference cited in the text is also present in the reference list (and vice versa). In addition, multiple citations (3 or more in the same brackets) must appear as a "[1-3]".

#### REFERENCES

Reference style

- 1. Single author: the author's name (without initials, unless there is ambiguity) and the year of publication;
- 2. Two authors: both authors' names and the year of publication;

3. Three or more authors: first author's name followed by 'et al.' and the year of publication.

The references must be listed in the order they appear in the main text.

### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

Font size: Use 11-point - Times New Roman

Line spacing: Single

Paper Margins: A4 size (Normal Margin i.e. top (2.54cm), bottom (2.54cm), left (2.54 cm), right

(2.54 cm)

Columns: Two columns Page number: Bottom-right.

Main body of the paper is to be written in Times New Roman, 11pt, text justified with single line spacing. Subtitles: times new roman, 11 pt, bold, justified aligned. Use two blank lines between the text and the next title. Paragraph spacing is to be kept as 6 pt. Name of the author presenting the paper should be underlined.

#### UNITS

The paper should use SI units. All figures and tables are to be properly numbered and captioned. Figures are to be aligned to the center with caption below the figure. Figure captions should be in Times New Roman, 10 pt, uppercase and centered. A table or figure should be referenced in the text by Figure or Table respectively followed by the figure/table number.

## LENGTH OF THE PAPER

The length of the paper inclusive of figures, tables and plots should be preferably 3-4 pages. It should not exceed 5 pages in any case.
